GENERAL INFORMATION

The Seventeenth Southeastern Consortium for Continuing Medical Education in Dermatology will be held in Atlanta, Georgia on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, October 1-3, 1993. It will be hosted by the Department of Dermatology at Emory University School of Medicine and the Atlanta Dermatological Association. The educational goal of the Consortium is to provide an update in one or two areas of clinical dermatology selected from a core curriculum. The meeting rotates every year among the participating institutions. Emphasis is placed on choosing effective speakers from the region encompassed by the Consortium.

MEETING PLACE

Registration and the Friday and Saturday sessions will meet at the Hotel Nikko in Uptown Atlanta (Buckhead area). Sunday morning patient presentations will be at The Emory Clinic.

CLINICAL MEETING SUNDAY OCTOBER 3

The Consortium clinical meeting at which patients are presented and discussed is co-sponsored by Emory and the Atlanta Dermatological Association. This session will be held at The Emory Clinic Central Building, Second (main) Floor. The Emory Clinic is located at 1365 Clifton Road NE. Parking is available in The Emory Clinic visitor parking deck.

Bus service will be available from the Hotel Nikko to The Emory Clinic and back.

Registration will begin at 8:00 AM and patient presentations will begin at 8:30 AM. The discussion of the patients will start at 10:00 AM across the street in the Emory University Hospital Auditorium (Main Floor).
